Mortlake Brewery development The revised plans are now with the Mayor of London – Sadiq Khan, and open for public consultation. There is more affordable housing, achieved by increasing the number of units from 893 to 1252. The parking is less, but no solutions are offered for the traffic problems. **The population of Mortlake will increase by 90%.** Mortlake Brewery Community Group website www.mbcg.org.uk has a summary and a suggested template letter to the Mayor. Our views count - the deadline is Sunday 27 September.

Food Bank: Following an update from the Vineyard Food Bank, in which they say they have 17 tons of donations in stock (enough for two months' supply) and now need funds for storage and for a new, larger van, Fr Alex is no longer collecting food donations for the Vineyard Food Bank at the Vicarage. Owing to the coronavirus measures numbers at both services are severely restricted, and we regret that only those invited by Tony's family may attend in person.
